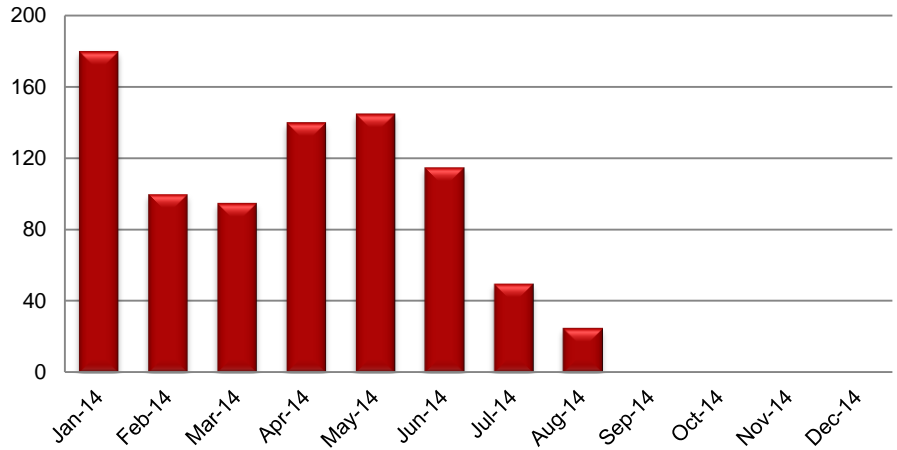


Waste and Recycling

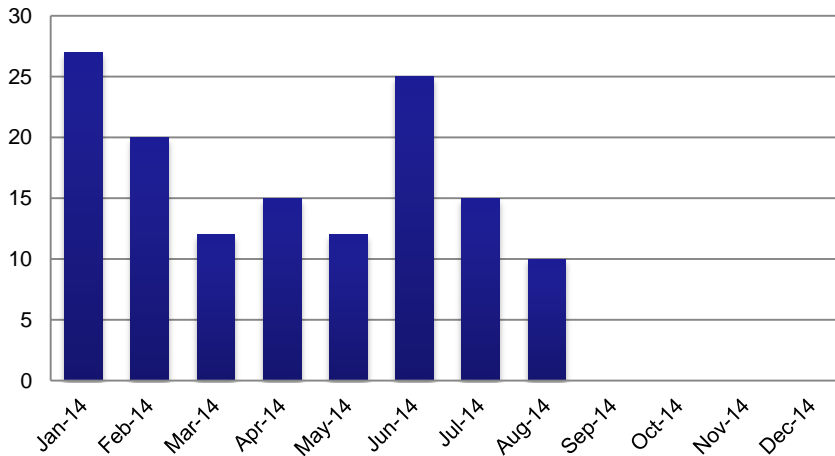
The amount that has been recycled year to date is lower than last year (1175 kg in 2013 compared to 850 kg 2014).

This does not mean that we are recycling less as paper usage has also decreased substantially. As the vast majority of recycling results from printing, this is actually a positive figure.

Paper usage

Our usage of paper has decreased this year, with orders being on average 17 reams per month compared to 29 reams last year. This is a decrease of 42%.

Electricity

Monthly electricity consumption has remained mostly consistent across the year. Overall the usage has decreased on average by 6%.

This also means that our CO2 emissions have also decreased.

It is vitally important that monitors, screens, fans and air conditioners are turned off when not in use.
